If you're over worried about remembering something, you'll forget it. And avoid being negative. If you keep telling your memory is bad, your mind will come to believe it and you won't remember things. When you forget something, do not care very much, because it will have a negative effect on you and your memory. To remember more, you'll need to take an active role.
